
Preparation and Cooking Instructions

PREPARATION: COOK TO A MINIMUM OF 165' F. BAKE IN SINGLE LAYER IN PREHEATED CONVECTION OVEN AT 350'F FOR 8-10 MIN. BAKE IN SINGLE LAYER IN PREHEATED CONVENTIONAL OVEN AT 400'F FOR 12-15 MIN. DEEP FRY AT 350'F, FOR 2-4 MIN. MICROWAVE ON HIGH ABOUT 1-3 MIN. PER SERVING, TURNING ONCE. ADJUST TIMES TO QUANTITY BEING COOKED AND EQUIPMENT USED. DO NOT OVERCOOK.



Protect cheeses from mold and dehydration by preventing exposure to air, wrapping tightly with plastic film without air pockets, using new plastic wrap each time opened, placing wrapped cheese in sealed container, and always working in clean area. Use First-In-First-Out (FIFO) storage practices to ensure use of older product first.
